We look forward to future wind farm projects in Mountainair.

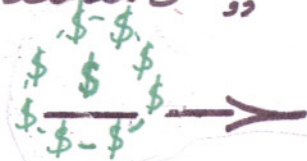

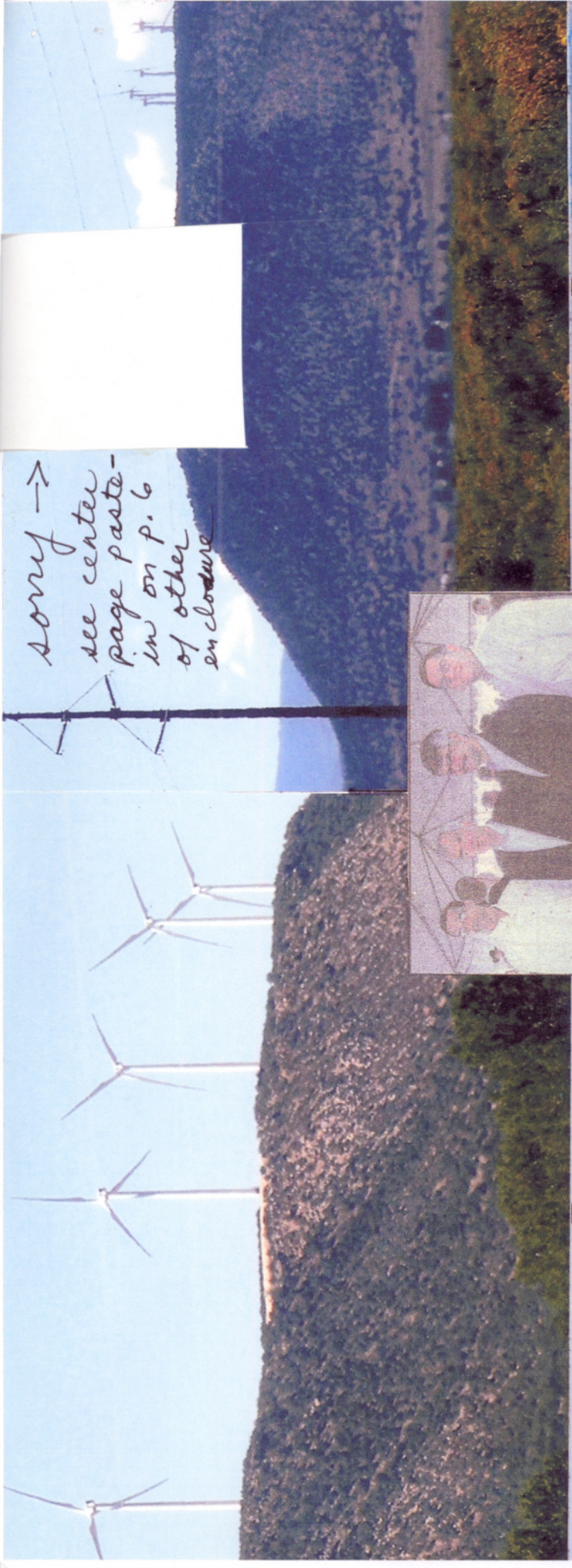
